First Day of School Welcome Breakfast (Tuesday, Sept. 1, 2016)

Social gathering for all Emerson parents and caregivers – enjoy a cup of coffee/snack and celebrate or recover from sending your kid(s) - especially kindergarteners - off on their first day of school.
